It was also encouraging to hear about the plans for the future of the school and the efforts being made to raise the funding needed to translate these plans into reality.

**Dr. lan Sykes** was appointed as Chair following the resignation of Revd. Ross Collins. We are grateful that Revd. Ross Collins remains a trustee. His vision and enthusiasm have been contagious, and we are thankful to him in what he helped the project achieve over the years.

There were five new trustees appointed. The new trustees are:

**Alan Wardle**, Deputy Head-teacher, Norton College, Worcester has taken on the role of **Treasurer and Company Secretary** following lan's appointment as Chair.

Gill Wardle, a former PE teacher and now teaching assistant

Gloria Phillips, an English teacher in a secondary school in Birmingham

Glenn Scott, a retired fundraiser with Oxfam

Gloria, Gill and Anne have the responsibility to maintain and develop links between Malek and schools in the UK. Glenn has the task of organising our fundraising efforts.





There will also be an emphasis on the history and geography of Sudan and the impact of conflict of the war on the lives of children and their families. Glenn is beginning, with the help of fellow trustees, to contact **grant giving bodies** to seek funding for various projects we have planned. Joseph and Glenn plan to visit Malek in January and hope to collect the uniforms and the solar generator equipment in Nairobi and take them to the school. Glenn will spend his time there gathering stories from the teachers, students and their families backed up with photos and video. Joseph will be working with the head-teacher, **Elias Bak Bak Anei** looking at the development of a **Teacher Training Programme** that we hope to see in place early next year. He will also be overseeing the installation of the the solar panels. On the return journey, Joseph and Glenn plan to stop over in Juba and Nairobi where they will arrange to visit organisations who might be able to work in partnership with the school and provide additional funding.
