Great news - the school community is really pleased to have just received the much needed replacement of 6 solar panels and batteries. It not only powers for example laptops for computer classes during the day, but means that when the primary school children go home, the light in the evening makes the teaching of adult education in the class rooms possible.



A huge THANK YOU for your earmarked donations towards our increase in food costs. The school supplements what they receive from the WHO so the children's daily meal can include meat. This meal has been key in the girls continuing to come to school, as the little food some families can supply their children with wouldn't give them the energy to walk to school and concentrate on their studies.

The girls continue to look after our cows and benefit from the milk.

And the bread oven is in constant use!

Prices continue to increase in South Sudan and the fall in the value of the pound against the dollar means our funds for the school are buying us 6 times less than they did two years ago.
